Christine Colvin is a senior hydrogeologist with the Water Competency Area of the CSIR, South Africa.

She obtained her MSc in Hydrogeology from University College London, studying the Windhoek aquifer, and has been practicing hydrogeology in Southern Africa since 1992, linking groundwater to Integrated Water Resources Management.

Christine is currently completing a PhD on ecosystem dependency on aquifers, examining ecosystems in the Cape, the Kruger Park and Mozambique. This has led her to ecohydrological research on linked water-carbon cycles and impacts of climate change.

She chairs the South African chapter of the International Association of Hydrogeologists (IAH) as well as the IAH Commission on Groundwater Dependent Ecosystems.
